KEY DATES & DEADLINES

During the summer residency, or shortly after, mentors and mentees are expected to work out a schedule of mailings. The dates can be somewhat flexible, depending on your own schedule, your mentor's schedule, and your projects. However, everyone involved should be clearly aware of the schedule of mailings, and any adjustments made to the schedule. In addition to the mentor/mentee mailing schedule, please note the deadlines below.

FOR ALL:

January 15: Mid-Year Assessment due.

May 15/30: Final student mailing by May 15; final mentor response by May 30.

June 3: Workshop submissions for the summer residency due; submitting them

earlier is appreciated. All through the spring, there will also be deadlines

associated with the summer residency.

June 30: Year-End Assessment due.

June 30: For 1st-Year and 2nd-Year students, the Cumulative Bibliography is

also due, preferably attached to the Year-End Assessment.

2ND-YEAR STUDENTS:

December 1: Outside Experience Proposal due.

July 1: Outside Experience Report due.

THESIS-YEAR STUDENTS:

December 15: Critical Paper due. Submissions well in advance of the deadline are

encouraged. After outside proofreading, revisions might be required.

March 1: Graduation Application must be completed on Banner.

April 30: Creative Thesis due. Submissions well in advance of the deadline are

encouraged. After outside proofreading, revisions might be required.

April 30: Full Program Bibliography due.

May-June: You will receive further instructions regarding forms and fees for

archival processing of the Creative Thesis.
